NOTICE OF MOTION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Applicant will apply urgently to the Chairperson of the Commission at [REDACTED], or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, for an order in the following terms:

1. That this application be heard as one of urgency and that the Applicant's non-compliance with the seven-calendar-day notice period prescribed by Rule 11.3 of the Rules Governing Proceedings of the Commission, and with any other applicable time period or form, be condoned in terms of Rules 11.3 and 11.4.
2. That the following documents be treated as confidential and not be made available to the public or the media, published, broadcast, disseminated or referred to in any public hearing, unless otherwise directed by the Chairperson:
 - 2.1. this notice of motion, the founding affidavit and any replying affidavit, together with all annexures thereto;
 - 2.2. every supporting or confirmatory affidavit filed in this application, together with all annexures thereto; and
 - 2.3. any response, report, submission or other document delivered by the Commission's Legal Team or any other person in relation to this application.

3. That the application for the confidentiality and in-camera relief sought in paragraph 2 above be heard in camera.
4. That only the Commissioners, the Secretary of the Commission, the Commission's Legal Team, the Applicant's legal representatives and such other persons as the Chairperson may expressly authorise be permitted to attend the hearing referred to in paragraph 3 above.
5. That the substantive application for the postponement of the continuation of the Applicant's evidence likewise be heard in camera and subject to the attendance restrictions set out in paragraph 4 above.
6. That the continuation of the Applicant's evidence, which was scheduled to resume on 15 July 2026, be postponed until a date to be determined by the Chairperson after consideration of further medical information concerning the Applicant's condition and capacity and after the Applicant has been certified medically fit to participate reliably in the Commission's proceedings.
7. That, pending the determination of a date for the continuation of his evidence, the Applicant be excused from attending or participating in Commission-related proceedings where his inability to do so is supported by a valid medical certificate or report, subject in each instance to the approval and further directions of the Chairperson.
8. That the exchange of papers and all further procedural steps in this application take place in accordance with the timetable agreed between the parties and directed by the Commission, namely:
 - 8.1. the Applicant shall deliver his notice of motion, founding affidavit and supporting affidavits by [REDACTED];
 - 8.2. the Commission's Legal Team shall deliver any answering papers or written submissions by [REDACTED]

- 8.3. the Applicant shall deliver any replying affidavit or supplementary written submissions by [REDACTED] and
- 8.4. the application shall be heard at [REDACTED], or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard.
9. That the Applicant be granted such further and/or alternative relief as the Chairperson considers appropriate.
