DIRECTIONS REGARDING THE USE OF CAMERAS AT HEARINGS OF THE JUDICIAL COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO CRIMINALITY, POLITICAL INTERFERENCE AND CORRUPTION IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM

Following the directions issued by Justice Mbuyiseli Madlanga on 23 October 2025, all members of the media covering the Commission's hearings at the Brigitte Mabandla Justice College should note the following:

- Cameras must not capture or transmit any images of the screens of electronic devices belonging to or being operated by Commission staff. This includes the laptops, tablets and cell phones of commissioners, evidence leaders, members of the secretariat, or any other staff.
- Only the content which is projected by the Commission on the large television screens inside the auditorium may be captured for broadcast or publication.
- All media are requested to take particular care in ensuring that they do not publicise information which is not for public consumption.

The Commission recognises and appreciates the role played by the media in enabling the public's access to the proceedings.
