STATEMENT BY JEREMY MICHAELS, SPOKESPERSON OF THE JUDICIAL COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO CRIMINALITY, POLITICAL INTERFERENCE AND CORRUPTION IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM

The Judicial Commission of Inquiry into Criminality, Political Interference and Corruption in the Criminal Justice System will hold public hearings at the Brigitte Mabandla Justice College from 27 to 31 October 2025.

The witness for Monday, 27 October 2025, is a South African Police Service ballistics expert who will take the stand at 09h30.

Two other witnesses will appear before the Commission as follows:

- 1. On Tuesday, 28 October 2025, a witness will testify remotely but on camera.
- 2. On Thursday, 30 October 2025, Witness C will return to the stand and again testify partially in camera. As per the ruling by Justice Mbuyiseli Madlanga on 14 October 2025, Witness C will testify off camera from a remote location but the proceedings will be open to the public and media.

Further announcements will be made regarding the other witnesses appearing before the Commission for the rest of this week.
