STATEMENT BY JEREMY MICHAELS, SPOKESPERSON OF THE JUDICIAL COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO CRIMINALITY, POLITICAL INTERFERENCE AND CORRUPTION IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM

The Judicial Commission of Inquiry into Criminality, Political Interference and Corruption in the Criminal Justice System wishes to announce that the first public hearing scheduled for 17 September 2025 will start at 10h00. Thereafter, the Commission's public hearings will commence at 09h30.

The seating for members of the public is limited to 300. People attending will be seated on a first come, first served basis. Therefore, members of the public must arrive early if they wish to secure a seat.

An additional reason for early arrival is that strict access control measures will be in place and no unauthorised entry will be permitted.

As previously announced, the venue is the Bridgette Mabandla Justice College, located at 332 Johannes Ramokhoase Street, Pretoria. Public access to the venue is via the entrance on Struben Street, between Lillian Ngoyi and Sisulu Streets.

Members of the public should note that parking at the Justice College is very limited. It is therefore advisable to seek alternative parking.
